This evil act of Sri Lankan genocide, must be highlighted and stopped immediately! Another act of Genocide! TAG should include this in their case against Sri Lankan government.





Image of Murukan desecrated during the destruction a few days back. It was already a broken image when found in the ancient ruins and was fixed together

A Siva temple located at an ancient Hindu site called Akaththiyar Thaapanam, at Kangku-veali in the Moothoor division of the Trincomalee district, where Hindus gather especially to perform the Aadi Amaavaasai ritual for ancestors, was destroyed without any traces coinciding the Heroes' Day on 27 November. The location of the temple is under the control of Sri Lanka Army stationed at a nearby Sinhala village, Neelaappola. The Sinhala villagers of Neelaappola protected the Tamil villagers of Kangku-veali from displacement in 2006. The Tamil villagers who were shocked and wept to see the temple razed to the ground now, suspect 'outsiders' and are scared whether this is a prelude to wipe out their traditional village as well.


Political and economic inequalities between Tamil Eelam and Sri Lanka within a single Ceylonese society



Since 1948 systematically excluding Tamils from prestigious social and political positions.

Claiming sovereignty over Tamil Eelam over Tamil Eelam

Building and maintaining of colonies in one territory (Tamil Eelam = 2 Provinces) by people (Sinhalese) from another territory (Sri Lanka = 7 Provinces)



Sri Lanka is claiming sovereignty over Tamil Eelam.

Dismantled De facto state of Tamil Eelam.

Initiating economic development in the colonised areas and producing wealth for the benefit of Sinhalese.
