

## Foreword

I do not possess the skill nor the authorship to write the foreword for this book comprised of my dear husband's letters. Despite this shortcoming, I sincerely wish to write a great deal about him.

I learned more about him from talking to the people around him, friends, and relatives than I did on my own.

It was my wish to share his thoughts with the same people that made me initiate the process of publishing an excerpt of the letters that he wrote during his final days.

Late in the year of 1983 I got my first opportunity to meet him in person.

Back then the Sri Lankan army used to invade every corner of Jaffna on a whim. It was during this time that the Liberation Tigers of Tamil Eelam started operating in hiding whilst placing themselves in grave danger for the sake of reclaiming our country's freedom and ensure the future wellbeing of our people.

Without sufficient food, sleep, or a safe base to stay, they led a righteous life rich in sacrifices. They devoted themselves completely and gladly to bring about a dawn for our country, and solely focused on their duty. All this contributed to me holding them in high regard.

When I finally met Kittu himself in person I felt as if I had encountered a person I had only previously heard of in stories and epic tales, but I actually got to meet such a brave hero and a self-sacrificing sage for the first time during my lifetime.

Ever since that day an unexplainable devotion and love for him arose in me. As the days passed this eventually blossomed into a wonderful relationship based on mutual belonging and love between the two of us.

He was the one who truly made me understand and impressed upon me the importance of providing a liberated world for our people, where they would be able to live as free people, and how history has tasked us with the duty of utilizing our given time and surroundings to achieve these goals.

Among his many talents was his deep spiritual devotion. His ability to sympathize with his adversaries and feel sorry for their families, whilst simultaneously being saddened by the hardships of the people in the battlefields and doing his utmost to resolve their troubles further revealed his generous and philanthropic heart to me. Furthermore, if anyone spoke of any new information that he was not already aware of, he had a habit of listening and learning like a inquisitive child from that person, no matter who it was. All these attributes increased my respect for him manifold.

His continuous effort and labors for the sake of our country's liberation and the betterment of our people's lives whilst located in Jaffna is widely known to all.

It was during those days on the  $30^{\text{th}}$  March 1987 that he unfortunately lost one of his legs due to an unexpected bomb attack.

Even while he was being treated for his wound and was under severe bodily pain his thoughts never strayed far from the struggle and the people. In 1987 he managed to convey his message by delivering speeches to his beloved people during the time of his treatment on two occasions: at the Labor Day convention in Nallur and the later in May at the Suthumalai assembly.

Later he travelled to India to continue his medical treatment. It was at that time that the war against the Indian army began on Tamil Eelam, and for that reason he was ordered to remain in house arrest in India.

Because the Indian army became aware of my relationship with him, I was also put under arrest early November in Jaffna. In late November I was brought to India by the Indian Army and put in house arrest till mid-September 1988 along with him. It was then I got the opportunity to truly learn from my husband's guidance, advice, and opinions.

Later in September 1988 him, myself, and the Liberation Tigers who were staying with us were brought to Chennai Central Jail and stayed there for 27 days. From there we were brought to Jaffna and finally released on the 12<sup>th</sup> of October 1988.

Thereafter he continued to work to realize his ambition from Tamil Eelam while in hiding.

On the 25<sup>th</sup> of October 1989, our wedding took place with god's blessing. After that he travelled to London to continue his work from there.

His many labors for the independence of Tamil Eelam continued in various forms from several different locations.

But from the moment of his departure till his last breath his thoughts never strayed far from his motherland

- and that he should see his beloved people again
- that he should mingle and be amongst them again
- I was very aware of how he desperately spent his every waking and sleeping moment devising how to create a liberated and joyful existence for them.

This sentiment is also apparent in several of his letters.

The manner of his affection for the land and the people and the sheer joy of his commitment to both were immeasurable. In order to promote the prosperity of the land and the people he was forced to be separated form this land. He faced and endured many obstacles and sorrows. From mid-March 1992 till his final moment he led an isolated life. He contentedly accepted such a secluded existence because it was in service of his people.

All his letters deal with topics such as

- the liberation of our people and nation
- the pride of serving the people
- the sacred ambition of human existence.

Furthermore, these letters contain random musings of my husband. Therefore, we should accept that his letters are not stringently linear, grammatically immaculate, or written in a posh language.

He would have rushed back to the Tamil Eelam-motherland heart brimming with his thousands upon thousands of wishes and dreams to see his people again, take part in their sorrow again, share his experiences and express his intentions to them, and ensure a true liberation and a bright future for them.

He and his comrades would have set out on their sea-journey full of excitement and eagerly expecting the moment that they would be able to set foot on the Tamil Eelam soil again.

But on his route back home, the creator must have written that it was time to bring him back by his side..., when I attempt to think about what must have happened at that moment my heart fearfully shudders in denial...

Without submitting to the enemy, and whilst protecting the honor of the Tamil mother and fighting for his ambition, he and his comrades attained martyrdom.

I stand before god and my departed husband and ask only for this: let me devote my life to the people and to the path of serving them demonstrated to me by my dear husband, who lived and died for their sake.

Dearest Laali,

I received your letters...

You also wrote about our people's travails. I was very saddened to hear it. Please keep me informed about these kinds of events frequently.

The Sri Lankan government keeps pressing a military solution forward. Sri Lanka continues to impose economic sanctions upon our people as well as starving and making them the object of suffering, espionage and turning them against the revolution by forcing them into an extremely critical situation. This agenda against our fight for freedom is not just Sri Lanka's but it is shared by the world and abided by several countries.

In essence, this is a very serious problem indeed. Ordinary people who live in their own small circle without a political understanding or longsightedness or individuals with degrees, who hold themselves to be intellectuals, will not be able to tolerate these kinds of difficulties. But we cannot expect more from them. They are all our people still, our treasures. Their sorrow is ours as well. Their standard of living needs to be developed.

We need to achieve our great ambition; our only intention is that our people will one day be able to live in lasting peace and freedom. We are forced to endure much suffering, sorrow and sadness; but do not lose faith no matter what you see.

Let the world and the incompetent people say whatever they want. Do not let them stop us from serving our people. "Public service is equivalent to serving Mahesan<sup>1</sup>". Serving our people and our people's life is our life, this is the truth.

Continue your studies with a stout heart. I love our land and our people infinitely. I wish to take part in our people's bereaved and neglected sorrow. There I wish to share their grievances and partake in it along with our people.

Yet you are already in possession of that blessing. Do no loose sight of the long-term consequences of events even if you are able to participate in the people's ordinary everyday lives today. Learn to approach problems with an open heart and a broad mindset. There is no life free of difficulties and sadness; there is nothing. It is the difficulties that make up life. This is the truth.

Furthermore, being suppressed and murdered by a tyrant is not unique to Tamil Eelam or Jaffna. This is the norm all around the world. There are numerous races who have overcome by rebelling against the tyrant's oppression. When compared to such rebellions our situation almost seems bearable to me.

I will continue to fight for our people to the best of my abilities and as long as I still have strength in me.

To Laali who is love,

There is plenty of work in Geneva. Days pass. It is a very beautiful country. I do not go outside. One can only admire one's surroundings if one's inner soul is at peace. Being separated from my country and my people is an extremely unbearable circumstance...... How am I to find peace in this kind of situation?

It is the greatest godsend to be at peace in one's inner soul. That is indeed true beauty. But how can mere outer beauty provide peace.

Every man is born and passes away. But it is the solace he aids to mankind that lasts. Serve to the best of your abilities. Do not spend your days in vain.

Furthermore, you are currently living amongst a small circle of self-interested and backwards thinking people. But do not get entwined in their delusional world. Be careful and think acutely. You will encounter several people like superficially grazing sheep who will not examine anything thoroughly, but instead will start preaching Vedantha philosophy despite having studied Siddhanta ideology. Their critique of the struggle for liberation will be like "four blind people assessing an elephant". Anyone is allowed to criticize anything. But one should point to possible solutions as well instead of just plain arrogant refusal. Any Siddhanta ideologist or philosopher should point to a solution that applies to the practical world, one cannot live in a delusional world. If not, it can only be called a warning.

Listen to what everyone has got to say; think, think carefully; think independently; no one will think for you.

Whenever I have the time, I continue to study what I can. There is so much we should learn about the world. You do the same. Do not just study your books, study the world and life as well.

They tell us something every day, every hour. The one who understands this properly and studies it becomes a sage. Do not get fooled by the smooth talk of phony philosophers who preach empty beliefs. Only thought and exploration can elevate a person. But a person will always have to compromise on his thinking for the sake others and the advancement of humankind. One should not just boast one's own wit and criticize others.

I have been given the opportunity to be a freedom fighter and dedicate myself to the dawn of my people during my lifetime, I perceive this to be the greatest blessing. It is my wish that I should be able to continue this blessing for the remainder of my lifetime. The reason we continue to fight is to bring about a peaceful and bright existence for our people. It does not seem as if our enemy will meet our needs or demands. They expect us to be satisfied with what they offer instead of being willing to hand us our rights. We are neither greedy nor ignorant of the way of the world. The basic right that we are asking for is the right for our people to live out their lives on our land. A provincial council or a council with even more power cannot ensure our safety. We are searching for a solution that will guarantee the complete safety of our people.

My dear Laali,

I have not received any of your letters since arriving to Geneva. For some reason I feel no excitement today. There is talk about largescale battles being carried out in Jaffna. I am filled with worry.

There are several changes in the western countries and an awareness that makes them more sympathetic towards our cause. But these changes have not yet taken root in Asia. However, we cannot lose faith because of that. We will continue to fight. That is the only way we can reclaim our rights.

We are a national race. We have the right to determine our own fate. This can also be said in the following manner. We have the right to determine our own political status. There is no need to be inferior to the Sri Lankan government. We are fighting for an independent country called Tamil Eelam. But we are simultaneously observing the novel political developments in the world. We have discovered the existence of a momentum for us to utilize like several other national races who have succeeded in gaining their sovereignty. Therefore, we will also create a sovereign and independent government and live side by side with equal status with the neighboring government of Sri Lanka. Finding a solution within the Sri Lankan government for our problems has become an impossibility that none of us can achieve. We are not going to accept such a solution either.

There are countless of Tamil people living as refugees abroad. There are 20 thousand Tamils in Swiss alone. There is growing determination in the European countries to send these Tamil refugees back. There has arisen a negative sentiment against our people in Germany and Swiss. Our people are targeted and attacked in many places. For this reason, these countries are trying to send them back. Not even the Tamils living abroad can live in peace. There is no freedom anywhere. It is only after a country of our own is created that we can live proudly anywhere. No matter how many tribulations our revolution faces we need to stand our ground and conquer them and become victorious. The people's tragedies and sorrows leave me extremely dispirited. But if we are afraid to suffer and give up our fight now, our race can never live peacefully. Therefore, we will bear any suffering and continue to fight.

We are not fighting to realize a Tamil Eelam just for our supporters only. It is for everyone. It is for those who support, do not support, and oppose us as a united group of people that we are fighting. About this we are certain and clear. But if we are to carry out our revolution, we cannot tolerate those who seek to destroy it and those who aid that.

There will always be troublemakers and dissatisfied individuals. They are however powerless beings. They are people who have not understood the true meaning of the revolution. Just like how a blind person sees the world, they view the revolution from the bottom of a well based on random knowledge they have gained somewhere. They are pretending to asleep; nobody can wake them up.

I am working as tirelessly as I can to ensure that our people can live well. I have made many attempts to initiate negotiations with the Sri Lankan government. But they believe in a military solution and seek to solve our problem using the military. One reason for this is that Sinhala racism has outgrown its politicians. Using cheap tactics these indecent politicians have created racial divisions amongst people who used to live in harmony. In 1956 Bandaranaike<sup>2</sup> of S.W.R.D<sup>3</sup> encouraged the racist sentiment against Tamils for the first time in order to gain power. This story has continued for forty years. Even to this day Premadasa's<sup>4</sup> opposition encourage hostility against Tamils to gain support amongst the Sinhala people.

In order to prove that he is a greater Sinhala person, Premadasa carries out even more destructive attacks against Tamils. Basically no one cares about the Tamil people.

Several changes are taking place around the world now. You must have heard of what recently happened to the Soviet Union. From a Soviet Union that once consisted of several different nationalities, each one has now broken away and gained their sovereignty. Each national race has emerged as entities capable of determining their own defense, finance, and foreign relations. Furthermore, they are willing to create a collective assembly where their representatives can gather in case of need. The international society has also accepted their declaration for freedom. Similarly, a part of Yugoslavia called Croatia wishes to become independent. Due to their status as a national race, Croatia is asking for the right to establish their own sovereign republic. The international society has also expressed their support for this.

To my dear Laali,

...... There is not much to write about me here. I have rented a small house for myself. The work is progressing somewhat. The remaining time I just spend studying. The cold weather has arrived. Swiss is a beautiful mountainous country. But it does not even come close to our country. Besides, we are unwanted guests here; our people are getting beaten several places here.

If we are to live proudly anywhere in this world we need to be able to live as autonomous citizens. We will not get accepted as refugees by everyone forever. We will only be able to live proudly if we get a country of our own. Please do not think that I preach comfortably from here while you all are living in great difficulty over there. It has become even more evident for me now after travelling abroad that we need a country of our own.

Despite us trying our best to solve our problems in a peaceful manner from here, Sri Lanka is not willing to understand our troubles. They keep on attempting to destroy us using military force. They keep telling us to put down our weapons and accept the provincial council-solution.

AK-47's are not intrinsically valuable to us. We only use our arms defensively. We need definite assurance that our Tamil people will be safe. Can we accept the Sinhalese forces as an assurance for our safety?

Some might believe us to be in love with our weapons, and not to know any other path besides the armed resistance. But we are not like that. I say this precisely because my insight in politics and the way of the world, if we are to regain our rights we need to fight.

If the enemy is willing to enter into a compromise, we will definitely not hesitate. However, our enemy keeps deceiving the world in the name of negotiation, compromise, and peace. At the same time, they are eager to concede to a provincial council solution through negotiation. And then they boast it to be a great "benefit".

What we need is our rights. We are a national race. We are entitled to rights. It is merely this we are asking for. We are more than willing to enter into talks about how two races with equal rights can live side by side peacefully on the island of Sri Lanka. But no Tamil is willing to subjugate himself to a Sri Lankan government obsessed with Sinhala supremacy again.

I am greatly saddened at the thought of our people. They continue to face endless troubles in their everyday lives. Death is only one part of it. Hunger and starvation are the other side. There is no end to these kinds of sufferings that they are forced to endure. We need to create prosperuos future for our people.

How are your studies coming along? You have gotten an opportunity to be of service to the people. Take care of our people to the best of your abilities. Serving the people is the greatest blessing. Even if we devote ourselves to religion by praying to god public service still emerges as the noblest cause.

Still, we are trying our best via the international society to pressure the Sri Lankan government into ceasing these attempts to attack. Several countries and international organizations have sanctioned the Sri Lankan government. And still, there is no way to predict what will happen.

Most importantly, you need to take care of your studies, your studies need to benefit the people. It needs to useful for the advancement of humanity. That is the reason why you are studying.

Degrees are not just a means to earning a higher salary. Neither is it merely a gateway to achieving greater status in society. Nor is not a matter of pride. When we say people, it addresses people with all kinds of demeanors. Both selfless individuals who live for others, individuals who is only concerned with their own wellbeing, and backwards thinking individuals.

You however need to engrave it in your heart that you need to finish your studies so that you can be of service to all these people.

Do not become spiteful because of the differences between human beings; there are precious gems amongst humans as well.

Strengthen your relations to decent people. Do not expect anything from the rest.

I have not received your letters lately. Why is that? I am doing very well. Please write about your wellbeing in your reply.

Nowadays all I do is to study. English, politics, general knowledge as well as drawing occupies me.

How are my friends? Please tell them that I asked for them.

I merely told you to focus on your studies, but not to do so incessantly like a machine. Take proper breaks in between studying. The heart benefits even more from rest than from studying and it will make you more receptable to further learning. Go to the temple as often as you can.

I have observed these so called first world countries, a label denoted to well-developed countries. But for some reason I am unable to compare them to my country. Despite wearing many layers of formal clothing and coats, I do not feel as magnificent as I do while wearing and walking around in a simple saaram.

Many tiered buildings and broad roads do not compare to our front yards.

Here I am constantly faced with foreign faces. They treat us in the same way. It is not possible to see the familiar faces from home here.

Our people live here bereft of their addresses, faces and identity! How can one live on this land?

One cannot form attachments to foreign surroundings. I survive because of the duty that I carry in my heart. Make sure that you do not allow any dreams of moving abroad during your lifetime to fester in your heart. Do not ever think that life abroad is heaven and the ticket to a life in luxury and without burdens. No country on earth comes close to our homeland. Every necessary thing for living a joyful life exists there. There is nothing but computers and machines here. Human beings are absent.

I pass my time somehow. My only wish and ambition is to serve my people and country to the best of my abilities.

My only sorrow is that I am not able to work fully for this cause after going abroad. If only I was back home, I would be able to do so much more. I am greatly saddened by the fact that I cannot put my talents to good use here. I am very much aware of how fleeting, precious and valuable each moment is. I cannot bear to think that my time is being wasted uselessly here. I am longing for my land and the wind that blows there.
