In addendum 1 to the report of the Special Representative of the Secretary-General on the situation of human rights defenders, Hina Jilani, to the sixty-second session of the Commission on Human Rights (E/CN.4/2005/95/Add.1), the following changes should be made to paragraphs 551, 552 and 554.

The first sentence of paragraph 551 *should read*:

In a letter dated 30 March 2005 the Government of Turkey responded to the communication of 17 February 2005.

Paragraph 552 *should read:*

In its response of 22 March 2005 the Government of Turkey stated that “the Ministry of Justice of Turkey gave the necessary permission to the Consul-General of Austria to visit Ms. Sandra Bakutz”.

Paragraph 554 *should read:*

The Governor’s Office initiated a preliminary inquiry and concluded that the notices had already been displayed when the four police officers, who were on duty on the day of the incident, arrived at the scene and that the police officers did not neglect their duty. Therefore, the Governor informed the Office of the Chief Public Prosecutor not to proceed with the investigation and, on 11 August 2005, the Chief Public Prosecutor decided that there was no legal cause to proceed with the investigation. This decision, which had been communicated to the concerned parties, became final as it was not challenged by the parties in the courts in the prescribed time limit.
